#### **Brimscombe Intentional Community Meeting**

The latest meeting of the group that is exploring the formation of an Intentional Community based at Brimscombe Methodist Church met on 14.10.17. The meeting looked at how a range of different intentional communities approached their community "rule" or "rhythm of life" or pattern of life", focusing on the following communities in particular:

The Bruderhof Darvell Community

Hilfield Franciscan Friary

Carrs Lane Lived Community

The Northumbria Community

The Franciscan Third Order

The meeting decided that we need to begin by summarising the core purpose/core vision of the community before we can consider any specific content to a community rule. The rule will emerge over time once the core vision is in place. It was agreed that each of us would bring to the next meeting a short summary of the key element(s) we would personally like to see included in a statement of the community's core purpose and vision. We would then use the next meeting to discuss and, ideally, agree a statement of the community's core purpose/vision. The next meeting will take place on Wednesday 11 November between 12.30-2.00pm at Brimscombe Methodist Church around a bring and share meal. If you are new to a role as a worker with children and young people, a pastoral visitor, a local preacher/worship leader, a representative on your church council or a church safeguarding coordinator, you may not have attended Foundation Safeguarding training. **YOU MUST ATTEND THIS COURSE!** The Government states that ALL volunteers should have safeguarding training every 5 years.

- Be able to respond appropriately to concerns about the safety and welfare of a child or vulnerable adult using the Methodist Church policies.
