The Time Is Now – Lobby Of Parliament

The Methodist Synod recently unanimously passed a resolution calling on the Methodist Conference to declare a Climate Emergency. If we want to put our own weight behind synod's conviction that there is a climate emergency, then there is a real opportunity to press our case coming now.

The Climate Coalition - the umbrella British climate movement with 130 member organisations - is organising a lobby of MPs at Westminster on Wednesday 26 June. Existing targets to tackle climate change are now widely recognised to not go far enough, so the Climate Coalition is calling on the government to put a net zero greenhouse emissions target by 2045 into law now and start working towards this immediately. The aim is to invite your MP to meet you on the day.
