### PASTORAL LETTER from the Superintendent, Revd Jayne Webb

Autumn 2025

Dear Friends,

Having now visited the majority of our 38 Churches across the Circuit (just a few more to go now), I want to take a moment to reflect on the mission we share — a mission deeply rooted in the heart of the gospel and expressed in the Methodist Church's '**God for All**' vision: **"A Church which is confident in sharing and living out the good news of Jesus Christ, and which is dedicated to growing flourishing communities of faith and transforming lives and society"**.

In **Matthew 9:35–38**, we see Jesus moved with deep compassion for the crowds: *"When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the labourers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest'".*

This passage reminds us that the mission of the Church begins with the compassion of Christ. It is his love for every person, without exception, that compels us to reach out, serve, and share the hope we have found in him.

Here in our towns and villages across Gloucestershire — whether in bustling streets or quiet rural lanes — there are many who long for good news, kindness, and genuine community. God calls us to be his hands and feet among them.

- To grow as disciples who speak naturally of Jesus in our daily lives,

- To serve our neighbours in practical ways that bring hope and transformation,
- To pray earnestly that the Lord of the harvest would raise up more workers — that each of us might discover the part we are called to play.

In the months ahead, may we continue to seek the Spirit's guidance in all we do. Let us be bold in love, generous in welcome, and faithful in prayer. May our churches be places where everyone can find the living Christ and know they are deeply loved.

I invite you to pray with me:

Lord of the harvest, send us out in the power of your Spirit. Give us your compassion for all people. Help us to share your good news, build communities of hope, and bring your transforming love to Gloucestershire and beyond. Amen.

Thank you for your faithfulness and for all the ways you serve Christ and our communities.

May God bless you and keep you always.

## PREACHER AND CHURCH NEWS

We were saddened to hear of the deaths of June and Frank Topping, Maurice Hall and Mary Westington.

June, wife of Revd Frank Topping and mother to Anne, Simon and Mark, passed away on 31 March and was laid to rest at Coalway Methodist Pysgah Chapel. June was known to many across the circuit through her commitment to methodism and community work. Revd Frank Topping, a well respected supernumerary minister, actor, producer, author and broadcaster who shared his reflections, prayers and meditations on Radio 2's *Pause for Thought*, subsequently passed away on 6 July and is now reunited with June. Maurice Hall, a Local Preacher accredited in 1957 and married to Bridget, was born and brought up in Cornwall. Maurice spent his working life with the Forestry Commission and served the churches in rural circuits for many years. Mary Westington, a Local Preacher accredited in 1959 and widow of the late Revd Douglas Westington, passed away on 28 June. Mary met Douglas when he was in his first appointment in Frome and will always be remembered for her support of his ministry and her open house and wonderful hospitality in each of his circuits.

We give thanks for the lives of June, Frank, Maurice and Mary and hold their family and friends in our prayers.

There is one Circuit Service shown on this plan. The service begins at 6pm and follows the Assembly where the business and mission of the Circuit is discussed. Hosted by Cirencester Ashcroft, the Assembly begins at 3pm and afternoon tea will be served afterwards.
